1. Any undergraduate degree with a minimum of 50%.
2. Must have taken the CAT, MAT, XAT, CMAT, GMAT, or ATMA entrance tests.

Fee Refund Policy

Withdrawal from the course may be permitted up to 4 weeks from the commencement of classes. Key features:

- Refund duration is based on course commencement, not the admission date.
- Costs for book kits, uniforms, and ID cards shall be deducted from the refund.
